METHOD OF WORK OF THE HEALTH ASSEMBLY
Annual Reporting by the Director-General

(Draft resolution proposed by Professor Julie Sulianti Saroso,
Dr D.D. Venediktov and the Rapporteurs)

The Executive Board,

Having considered the report of the Director-General on the subject
"Annual reporting by the Director-General"¹

AGREES, in principle, with the main proposals; and

RECOMMENDS to the Twenty-eighth World Health Assembly the adoption of
the following resolution:

"The Twenty-eighth World Health Assembly,

Having considered the report of the Director-General on the subject
"Annual reporting by the Director-General", and the recommendations of the
Executive Board thereon,

1. CONSIDERS it desirable that the Director-General should:

(a) publish in the Official Records in even numbered years, beginning in
1978, a comprehensive report on the work of WHO during the preceding two
years;

(b) issue in odd numbered years beginning in 1977, a short report covering
significant matters and developments during the preceding even numbered year;

(c) report on projects, hitherto listed in the Annual Report, in a separate
document, in such a form as to facilitate evaluation of the Organization's
programme; and

2. FURTHER CONSIDERS it desirable that the Executive Board at its fifty-seventh
session continue its review of the content and rationalization of the Director-
General's reports on the work of WHO."
