

ACTIVITIES OF THE WORLD HEALTH ORGANIZATION
WITH REGARD TO ASSISTANCE TO LIBERATION
MOVEMENTS IN SOUTHERN AFRICA PURSUANT TO THE
UNITED NATIONS GENERAL ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION
2918 (XXVII) AND ECOSOC RESOLUTION 1804 (LV)

Noting that invitations were extended to the national liberation movements recognized by the Organization of African Unity or the League of Arab States to send representatives to participate in an observer capacity to the 1974 sessions of the WHO Regional Committee for Africa and of Sub-Committee A of the WHO Regional Committee for the Eastern Mediterranean, respectively; and

Recognizing that attendance by representatives of the national liberation movements concerned in the meetings of the Organization would be facilitated if funds for that purpose were available, and recalling ECOSOC resolution 1892 (LVII),

RECOMMENDS to the Twenty-eighth World Health Assembly that it consider allocating the funds necessary to meet the expenses of attendance by a representative from each of the national liberation movements recognized by the Organization of African Unity or the League of Arab States at future meetings of the Organization to which they are invited in accordance with resolution WHA27.37.
