COORDINATION WITHIN THE UNITED NATIONS SYSTEM
REPORT OF THE INTERNATIONAL CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION

The fourth annual report of the International Civil Service Commission is submitted to the Executive Board in accordance with Article 17 of the Commission's Statute.

1. The Twenty-eighth World Health Assembly (May 1975), in resolution WHA28.28, accepted the Statute of the International Civil Service Commission. Under Article 17 of this Statute,¹ the Commission is required to submit an annual report to the United Nations General Assembly. This report is transmitted to the governing organs of the organizations in the United Nations system through their executive heads.
2. In accordance with this Article, the Director-General submits to the Executive Board herewith the fourth annual report of the International Civil Service Commission.² This report is also under consideration by the United Nations General Assembly. Any decision taken by the General Assembly regarding the report, particularly in connexion with its recommendations concerning entitlements of staff, will be reported separately to the Executive Board under the agenda item entitled "Confirmation of amendments to the Staff Rules" (provisional agenda item 26).
3. The report fully reflects the extent to which the Commission, in arriving at its decisions, has afforded the representatives of the administrations and the staff an opportunity to cooperate, as envisaged in the Statute, in the examination of all matters of interest to them. Its main proposals, in so far as they relate to the operation of the common system generally, do not therefore call for any further elaboration of the administrations' views beyond what is recorded in the report.
