REIMBURSEMENT OF TRAVEL COSTS OF REPRESENTATIVES
TO REGIONAL COMMITTEES

(Draft resolution proposed by the Rapporteurs)



The Executive Board,

Recalling resolution EB65.R2 concerning the recommendation of one regional committee that action should be taken for WHO to consider financing the cost of travel, excluding per diem, of a representative from each Member State to attend sessions of the regional committee;

Having noted the views and recommendations of the regional committees on this subject as reflected in the relevant resolutions adopted at their sessions in 1980;

RECOMMENDS to the Thirty-fourth World Health Assembly the adoption of the following resolution:

The Thirty-fourth World Health Assembly,

Having noted that in recent years certain Member States have either been unable to send representatives to sessions of regional committees because of financial constraints or have sent representatives despite incurring financial hardship;

Having noted further the views and recommendations of the regional committees and the Executive Board on this matter;

DECIDES that the cost of travel, excluding per diem, of one representative to sessions of regional committees may be financed by the Organization upon request of those Members and Associate Members whose contributions to the WHO regular budget are at the minimum rate in the scale of assessments.
