Mr President,

I refer to the letters of 14 May 1984, addressed to you by the delegation of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics and by the delegation of the German Democratic Republic respectively, which have been circulated in the Assembly as documents A37/INF.DOC./10 and A37/INF.DOC./9.

I also refer to the letter of 15 May 1984, addressed to you on this matter by the delegation of the United States of America also on behalf of the delegations of France and of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland.

The Government of the Federal Republic of Germany shares the positions set out in this letter addressed to you by the delegation of the United States of America on behalf of the Three Powers.

It regrets the attempts of the delegations of the Union of the Soviet Socialist Republics and of the German Democratic Republic to interfere with the appointment of Dr Ruth Mattheis as a member of the delegation of the Federal Republic of Germany to the 37th World Health Assembly.

It is, as a matter of principle, for every Member country alone to decide which institutions or persons it wishes to involve in its contributions to the work of this organization.

My Government, therefore, regrets that the cooperation within the framework of this conference is hampered by the politically motivated statements such as those made by the delegations of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics and of the German Democratic Republic.

I should be grateful if you would circulate this letter as an official document of the 37th World Health Assembly.

Please accept, Mr President, the assurances of my highest consideration.
