GLOBAL STRATEGY FOR THE PREVENTION AND CONTROL OF AIDS

(Draft resolution proposed by the Rapporteurs)



The Executive Board,

Having reviewed the report of the Director-General on the global strategy for the prevention and control of AIDS;¹

1. THANKS the Director-General for his report;
2. NOTES with satisfaction:

(1) WHO's continuing efforts to provide strong and effective leadership in global activities for the prevention and control of AIDS;

(2) the active collaboration established between over 90% of Member States and WHO in support national AIDS programmes;

3. RECOMMENDS to the Forty-second World Health Assembly the adoption of the following resolution:

The Forty-second World Health Assembly,

Having considered the report of the Director-General on the global strategy for the prevention and control of AIDS;

Noting with satisfaction the strong support manifested by all Member States for the global AIDS strategy and the growing financial support from countries for the global effort;

Expressing appreciation to all organizations and bodies of the United Nations system, and the many nongovernmental organizations concerned, for their active collaboration in support of the global AIDS strategy;

Welcoming the spirit of international collaboration manifested by the many scientists from all countries who are working closely with WHO, and with one another, in addressing the formidable scientific challenges of the AIDS pandemic;

Highly appreciative of the way in which WHO organized World AIDS Day and of the response of individuals, organizations and governments worldwide, and noting the high level of interest in maintaining World AIDS Day as an annual focus of the global effort against AIDS;
