First Report



The Committee on Nominations, consisting of delegates of the following Member States: Australia, Bulgaria, Burma, China, Colombia, Comoros, Congo, Cyprus, Ethiopia, France, Guatemala, Guyana, Italy, Liberia, Mexico, Morocco, Mozambique, Qatar, Somalia, Sri Lanka, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United States of America and Zimbabwe met on 2 May 1988. Dr D. de Souza (Australia) was elected Chairman.

In accordance with Rule 25 of the Rules of Procedure of the Health Assembly and respecting the practice of regional rotation that the Assembly has followed for many years in this regard, the Committee decided to propose to the Assembly the nomination of Professor D. Ngandu-Kabeya (Zaire) for the Office of President of the Forty-first World Health Assembly.
