UNITED NATIONS JOINT STAFF PENSION FUND

Appointment of representatives to the WHO Staff Pension Committee

The World Health Assembly is called upon to appoint two representatives to the WHO Staff Pension Committee to replace a member and an alternate member whose terms of office expire at the closure of the Forty-third World Health Assembly.

1. In conformity with the Regulations of the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund, and in accordance with resolution WHA2.49 of the Second World Health Assembly, WHO has a Staff Pension Committee composed of nine members (and nine alternate members) - three appointed by the World Health Assembly, three appointed by the Director-General, and three elected by the participants in the Fund. Appointments have normally been for a period of three years.

2. The present representatives of the World Health Assembly are:

- (1) Appointed by the Fortieth World Health Assembly (decision WHA40(12)):¹
 - the member of the Executive Board designated by the Government of Malawi;
 - the member of the Executive Board designated by the Government of Japan (as alternate).
- (2) Appointed by the Forty-first World Health Assembly (decision WHA41(12)):²
 - Sir John Reid (in a personal capacity);
 - the member of the Executive Board designated by the Government of the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya (as alternate).
- (3) Appointed by the Forty-second World Health Assembly (decision WHA42(11)):³
 - the member of the Executive Board designated by the Government of Colombia;
 - the member of the Executive Board designated by the Government of Democratic People's Republic of Korea (as alternate).

3. The terms of office of the member of the Executive Board designated by the Government of Malawi and of the member of the Executive Board designated by the Government of Japan will expire at the closure of the Forty-third World Health Assembly.
4. Following the precedent established by previous World Health Assemblies, the Forty-third World Health Assembly may wish to appoint its new representatives on the WHO Staff Pension Committee from among the members of the Executive Board by selecting two Member States entitled to designate a person to serve on the Board. The practice of the Assembly in the past has been to ensure that all WHO regions are equitably represented on the WHO Staff Pension Committee. The Assembly has therefore always selected Member States from regions no longer represented on the Committee.
5. The action required of the World Health Assembly is thus a decision appointing from among the members of the Executive Board designated by Member States from the Western Pacific Region and the African Region - the two regions no longer represented - a member and an alternate member of the WHO Staff Pension Committee, both appointments being for a period of three years.
