



FORTY-FOURTH WORLD HEALTH ASSEMBLY

REPORT OF COMMITTEE B TO COMMITTEE A

(DRAFT)

During the course of its second meeting held on 10 May 1991, Committee B considered the recommendation on the use of available casual income to help finance the 1992-1993 budget as contained in the report of the Executive Board on its review of the proposed programme budget for 1992-1993 and the first report of the Committee of the Executive Board to Consider Certain Financial Matters prior to the Forty-fourth World Health Assembly. The Committee decided to recommend to Committee A that US\$ 24 929 000 of available casual income be used to help finance the budget for 1992-1993.

The Committee further decided to endorse the proposal made by the Director-General regarding the adjustment of the budgetary exchange rates for 1992-1993 in the light of currency exchange developments up to May 1991 resulting in the reduction of the level of the proposed effective working budget by US\$ 28 824 000, i.e. from US\$ 763 760 000 to US\$ 734 936 000.
