About the middle of March, three cases of Influenza B were serologically verified, in Örebro and Västerås in central Sweden; however, the overwhelming majority of tests carried out are in favour of Influenza A2. Since the epidemic started, the average weekly incidence of cases of adenovirus infection, verified by virus isolations and complement fixation tests, is lower than that recorded for the first quarter of last year.
