GRIPPE

Asie

Japan. — Une poussée de grippe B a été signalée en décembre 1960 dans une école primaire de Tokyo.

Europe

Comme chaque hiver à pareille époque, l'incidence des affections qualifiées cliniquement « grippe » ou « influenza » s'accroît plus ou moins dans quelques-uns des pays où la déclaration de la maladie est obligatoire. Tel est le cas en Italie et en Suisse. Au Royaume-Uni¹ plusieurs souches de virus actuellement à l'étude mais qui appartiennent probablement au sous-groupe A2 ont été isolées; les examens de laboratoire se poursuivent.

INFLUENZA

Asia

Japan. — A small outbreak of virus B influenza was reported in a class of a primary school in Tokyo in December 1960.

Europe

As each winter, the frequency of infections, clinically designated as influenza, is increasing to a greater or lesser extent in some of the countries where the notification of the disease is compulsory. This is the case in Italy and Switzerland. In the United Kingdom¹ several strains not yet completely studied but very similar to A2 virus have been isolated; laboratory tests are proceeding.

FIÈVRE JAUNE DE JUNGLE

Amérique

Venezuela. — A la suite d'une épizootie survenue dans la forêt de San Camilo où la fièvre jaune de jungle a été constatée maintes fois au cours des années précédentes, un cas humain mortel a été signalé dans le district d'Uribante, Etat de Tachira, à la fin de décembre 1960¹. Les vaccinations antiamariles périodiques pratiquées dans cette région depuis l'année 1944 ont couvert pratiquement l'ensemble de la population; 627 ont été faites en 1960.

Le malade — un homme de 26 ans — venait de Capacho, zone d'altitude dans les Andes vénézuéliennes où la fièvre jaune est inconnue.

JUNGLE YELLOW FEVER

America

Venezuela. — Following an epizootic in San Camilo forest where jungle yellow fever occurred repeatedly in previous years, a fatal human case was reported in Uribante District, State of Tachira, at the end of December 1960¹. Periodic yellow-fever vaccination campaigns have been carried out in this area since 1944 and covered practically the whole population; 627 persons were vaccinated in 1960.

The patient, a 26-year old male, came from Capacho, a Venezuelan Andean region of high altitude where yellow fever is unknown.
