*République fédérale d'Allemagne*<sup>1</sup>. — *Ansbach*: Le 7 avril, la mère du jeune homme atteint de variole (cas importé) était également reconnue atteinte de la maladie. L'administration sanitaire intéressée a informé l'Organisation, en date du 7 avril, que la ville d'Ansbach était considérée, depuis ce jour-là, comme une circonscription infectée de variole. Ce renseignement a été diffusé dans le Bulletin épidémiologique radiotélégraphique quotidien de Genève (section deux) du 8 avril. Le deuxième cas non importé, diagnostiqué le 10 avril, a été notifié le même jour à l'Organisation. Il s'agit du père du cas initial. Les deux cas secondaires ont été isolés dans un établissement hospitalier le 30 mars et vaccinés le lendemain. La mère (premier cas non importé) est décédée le 10 avril (variole hémorragique). Aucun autre cas secondaire n'a été notifié à la date du 13 avril. Au 11 avril, le nombre des vaccinations effectuées à Ansbach était de 11 000.

*URSS.* — *Moscou*: L'Organisation a été informée télégraphiquement le 8 avril qu'un voyageur arrivé de Delhi (Inde), par voie aérienne le 6 avril, a été hospitalisé: diagnostic clinique de variole. L'Organisation a diffusé cette information dans le Bulletin épidémiologique radiotélégraphique quotidien de Genève (section trois) du 10 avril. Par la suite, l'Organisation a appris que ce voyageur faisait partie des 55 passagers du vol SU 054 de l'Aéroflot. Le Ministère de la Santé de l'URSS a informé les administrations sanitaires des pays intéressés en ce qui concernait les 10 étrangers voyageant par le même avion. Trois d'entre eux ont gagné Bucarest, Copenhague et Varsovie. Les 52 autres passagers ont été isolés à Moscou.

*Il est rappelé qu'aux termes du Règlement sanitaire international, la ville de Moscou, en raison de ce cas importé, ne saurait être considérée comme une circonscription infectée.*

SMALLPOX

Europe

*Federal Republic of Germany*<sup>1</sup>. — *Ansbach*: The disease of the mother of the imported case was confirmed as smallpox on 7 April. Under the provisions of Article 3 of the International Sanitary Regulations, the health administration notified the Organization on 7 April that Stadt Kreis Ansbach became a smallpox infected local area on that day. This information was included in Section two of the Geneva Daily Epidemiological Radio-telegraphic Bulletin on 8 April. On 10 April the second non-imported case was confirmed and was notified to the Organization on that day. The second contact case is the father of the imported case. Both contact cases had been isolated in hospital on 30 March, and vaccinated on the following day. The mother (first non-imported case) died on 10 April of haemorrhagic smallpox. By 13 April no other secondary cases had been notified. Some 11 000 vaccinations have been carried out in Ansbach up to 11 April.

*USSR.* — *Moscow*: By telegram sent on 8 April the Organization was notified that a traveller arriving by air from Delhi, India, on 6 April, had been hospitalized with a clinical diagnosis of smallpox. This information was included in Section three of the Geneva Daily Epidemiological Radio-telegraphic Bulletin on 10 April. Subsequently the Organization was informed that this traveller was one of 55 passengers on Aeroflot, flight number SU 054. The USSR Ministry of Health has informed the health administrations of countries concerned regarding the 10 foreigners on this plane. Three of the 10 proceeded to Bucharest, Copenhagen and Warsaw. The remaining 52 passengers are isolated in Moscow.

*It is recalled that under the provisions of the International Sanitary Regulations, Moscow, on the basis of this imported case, may not be considered as a smallpox infected local area.*

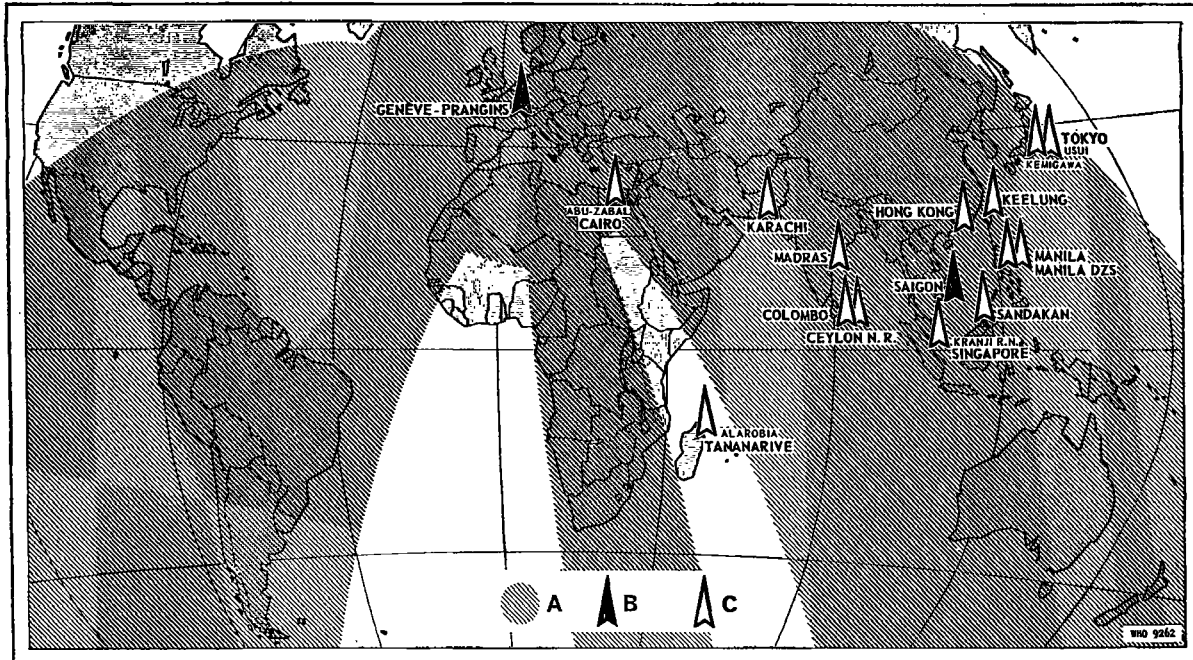

L'Organisation mondiale de la Santé, à Genève, transmet par l'intermédiaire des postes émetteurs de Radio Suisse S. A. (Genève-Prangins), un *Bulletin épidémiologique radiotélégraphique quotidien* destiné aux administrations sanitaires. Ce bulletin contient les renseignements officiels reçus par l'OMS, à Genève, sur les cas de maladies quaranténaires, c'est-à-dire de peste, choléra, fièvre jaune, variole, typhus et fièvre récurrente, constatés dans les ports et les aéroports (section une); sur les déclarations de circonscriptions infectées; sur les déclarations de circonscriptions redevenues indemnes lorsqu'il s'agit a) d'un port ou d'un aéroport; b) de la dernière circonscription qui restait encore infectée par une maladie quarantenaire donnée, dans un pays (section deux); sur les cas de maladies quaranténaires constatés dans des localités autres que ports et aéroports (section trois); et enfin sur les épidémies de maladies non quaranténaires ayant un intérêt international suffisant (section quatre).

Les derniers renseignements reçus suivis des mots « fin des dernières informations » sont communiqués au début du message, afin de réduire les frais de réception des administrations sanitaires. Lorsqu'il n'y a pas de changement, le mot « répétition » précède le texte du bulletin.

Le bulletin est un complément au *Relevé épidémiologique hebdomadaire*.

Les conditions de réception du bulletin, ainsi que toutes observations et suggestions opportunes au sujet de sa teneur, seront signalées au Service de la Quarantaine internationale, OMS, Genève (adresse télégraphique: EPIDNATIONS GENEVE).

Les postes émetteurs de Genève-Prangins qui transmettent le *Bulletin épidémiologique radiotélégraphique de l'OMS* sont indiqués à la page 88.

The World Health Organization transmits over the Radio Suisse S. A. wireless station (Genève-Prangins) a *Daily Epidemiological Radio Bulletin* destined for health administrations. This bulletin contains official information received by WHO in Geneva on the occurrence of the quarantinable diseases, i.e. plague, cholera, yellow fever, smallpox, typhus and relapsing fever, in ports and airports (section one); on declarations of areas as infected or free from infection — declarations of areas free from infection are included only if (a) the area is a port or airport, or (b) the area is the last infected area for that particular disease in that country (section two); on cases of the quarantinable diseases in localities other than ports and airports (section three); and on outbreaks of non-quarantinable diseases, if of sufficient international interest (section four).

The "latest information", followed by the words "end of latest information" is given at the beginning of the message, in order to reduce the cost of reception to health administrations. Whenever the text is not modified the word "repetition" is given at the beginning of the message.

The Bulletin complements the *Weekly Epidemiological Record*.

Reports on conditions of reception, and any comments and suggestions regarding the contents of the bulletin, should be communicated to the International Quarantine Service, WHO, Geneva (cable address: EPIDNATIONS GENEVA).
