L'Organisation mondiale de la Santé, à Genève, transmet par l'intermédiaire des postes émetteurs de Radio Suisse S. A. (Genève-Prangins), un *Bulletin épidémiologique radiotélégraphique quotidien* destiné aux administrations sanitaires. Ce bulletin contient les renseignements officiels reçus par l'OMS, à Genève, sur les cas de maladies quaranténaires, c'est-à-dire de peste, choléra, fièvre jaune, variole, typhus et fièvre récurrente, constatés dans les ports et les aéroports (section une); sur les déclarations de circonscriptions infectées; sur les déclarations de circonscriptions redevenues indemnes lorsqu'il s'agit a) d'un port ou d'un aéroport; b) de la dernière circonscription qui restait encore infectée par une maladie quarantenaire donnée, dans un pays (section deux); sur les cas de maladies quaranténaires constatés dans des localités autres que ports et aéroports (section trois); et enfin sur les épidémies de maladies non quaranténaires ayant un intérêt international suffisant (section quatre).

Les derniers renseignements reçus suivis des mots « fin des dernières informations » sont communiqués au début du message, afin de réduire les frais de réception des administrations sanitaires. Lorsqu'il n'y a pas de changement, le mot « répétition » précède le texte du bulletin.

Le bulletin est un complément au *Relevé épidémiologique hebdomadaire*.

The World Health Organization transmits over the Radio Suisse S. A. wireless station (Genève-Prangins) a *Daily Epidemiological Radio Bulletin* destined for health administrations. This bulletin contains official information received by WHO in Geneva on the occurrence of the quarantinable diseases, i.e. plague, cholera, yellow fever, smallpox, typhus and relapsing fever, in ports and airports (section one); on declarations of areas as infected or free from infection — declarations of areas free from infection are included only if (a) the area is a port or airport, or (b) the area is the last infected area for that particular disease in that country (section two); on cases of the quarantinable diseases in localities other than ports and airports (section three); and on outbreaks of non-quarantinable diseases, if of sufficient international interest (section four).

The "latest information", followed by the words "end of latest information" is given at the beginning of the message, in order to reduce the cost of reception to health administrations. Whenever the text is not modified the word "repetition" is given at the beginning of the message.

The Bulletin complements the *Weekly Epidemiological Record*.

Reports on conditions of reception, and any comments and suggestions regarding the contents of the bulletin, should be communicated to the International Quarantine Service, WHO, Geneva (cable address: EPIDNATIONS GENEVA).

The Genève-Prangins stations transmitting the *Daily Epidemiological Radio Bulletin of WHO* are listed on page 306.

CHOLÉRA

Asie

Sarawak. — Une poussée de choléra était signalée, le 14 juillet 1961, dans la région de Kuching. Le nombre des cas notifiés au 18 juillet était de 93 (avec 9 décès) dans la région de Kuching et de 23 (avec 11 décès) dans la région de Lundu. Un cas, provenant de la région de Kuching, a été signalé dans la région de Sibü. Conformément à l'article 3 du Règlement sanitaire international, la Division de Kuching (1^{re} Division) a été notifiée comme circonscription infectée de choléra dès le 14 juillet. Le bulletin épidémiologique radiotélégraphique de l'OMS diffuse cette information depuis le 16 juillet 1961.

Etats-Unis d'Amérique: Anchorage, Alaska. —¹ L'Organisation a été informée le 15 juillet 1961 que le cas suspect de variole, à Anchorage, s'est révélé être un cas de varicelle. Ce diagnostic a été communiqué télégraphiquement, le 15 juillet, aux administrations sanitaires des pays de destination des voyageurs du vol S.A.S. SK 988. CHOLERA

Asia

Sarawak. — An outbreak of cholera was reported on 14 July 1961 in the Kuching area. Up to 18 July, 93 cases and 9 deaths were notified in the Kuching area and 23 cases and 11 deaths in the Lundu area. One case, originating in the Kuching area, was reported in the Sibü area. The division of Kuching (1st Division) was notified, under the provisions of Article 3 of the International Sanitary Regulations, as a cholera infected local area as of 14 July. The information above was given in the WHO daily epidemiological radio-telegraphic bulletin beginning 16 July 1961.

SMALLPOX

America

United States of America: Anchorage, Alaska. —¹ The Organization was notified on 15 July 1961 that the smallpox suspect case at Anchorage had been diagnosed as chickenpox. Health administrations, to whose territory passengers on that S.A.S. flight SK 988 were proceeding from Copenhagen, were informed by telegram on 15 July of the revised diagnosis of the case. The WHO daily epidemiological radio-telegraphic bulletin beginning on 16 July carried the following information: „Section three reported 14 July suspect case Anchorage not smallpox”.
