Dans son huitième rapport, ultérieurement adopté par la quatorzième Assemblée mondiale de la Santé, le Comité de la Quarantaine internationale a prié le Directeur général de demander aux Gouvernements dans quelle mesure leurs aéroports internationaux sont maintenus indemnes d'*Aedes aegypti* et de moustiques vecteurs du paludisme et d'autres maladies.

Les réponses reçues des Etats au sujet d'*Aedes aegypti* sont résumées ci-dessous. Des informations supplémentaires seront publiées périodiquement au fur et à mesure de leur réception.

Dans les pays des Amériques où l'éradication d'*Aedes aegypti* a été obtenue, les aéroports qui ont des liaisons aériennes avec des localités infectées sont inspectés tous les six à douze mois. Là où l'éradication n'a pas encore été réalisée, le tableau donne des renseignements sur l'aéroport ou sur la ville adjacente (aéroport compris).

Il est bien entendu que la présence ou l'absence d'insectes vecteurs dans les aéroports dépend, non seulement de conditions saisonnières, climatiques et entomologiques, mais aussi de la présence de services compétents de lutte contre les vecteurs.

Les données relatives aux moustiques vecteurs du paludisme et autres maladies seront présentées séparément.

The Committee on International Quarantine in its eighth report, subsequently adopted by the Fourteenth World Health Assembly requested the Director-General to inquire of Governments on the extent to which their international airports are kept free from *Aedes aegypti* and mosquito vectors of malaria and other diseases.

The replies received from States in respect of *Aedes aegypti* are summarized below. Additional information received will be published periodically.

For countries in the Americas where *Aedes aegypti* eradication has been completed, airports with traffic from infected localities are inspected at 6-12 month intervals. Where eradication has not yet been completed the table contains data for the airport or the adjacent city including the airport.

It will be appreciated that the presence or absence of insect vectors at airports depends not only on seasonal, climatic and entomological conditions, but also on competent services for vector control being available.

Information on mosquito vectors of malaria and other diseases will be dealt with separately.

Hong Kong: Yuenlong District (Nouveaux Territoires). —¹ Le 29 octobre, Hong Kong a été déclaré indemne de choléra aux termes de l'Article 6 du Règlement. Il y a lieu de noter qu'avant de déclarer Hong Kong indemne d'infection, l'administration sanitaire a attendu que se soit écoulé un laps de temps égal à trois fois la période d'incubation, alors que le minimum requis est le double de la période d'incubation.

Un seul cas avait été enregistré et cinq contacts, dont deux porteurs sains, avaient été isolés au Centre de Quarantaine. Par la suite, l'examen de prélèvements rectaux permit de déceler, parmi les 410 habitants du village de Shan Pui, 14 nouveaux porteurs qui furent également isolés au Centre de Quarantaine. 32 personnes au total furent isolées, dont 16 porteurs sains.

Inde: Madras (P, A). —² Le 23 octobre 1962, la circonscription de Madras (P, A) a été déclarée, par l'administration sanitaire de l'Inde, circonscription infectée de choléra aux termes de l'Article 3 du Règlement. Un télégramme reçu ultérieurement signalait 27 cas et 1 décès pour la semaine terminée le 20 octobre. 119 cas et 10 décès ont été rapportés pour la semaine terminée le 27 octobre. Aucun cas de choléra n'avait été signalé pour la ville de Madras depuis le 7 mars 1959 et pour l'Etat de Madras depuis octobre 1961.

Macao. —¹ Un nouveau cas de choléra El Tor chez un enfant de 4 ans habitant Macao a été confirmé par le laboratoire le 25 octobre. Onze contacts de ce cas ont été isolés.

Trois cas — dont un cas importé — ont été signalés au 1^{er} novembre.

Hong Kong: District of Yuenlong (New Territories). —¹ Hong Kong was declared free of cholera on 29 October under the provisions of Article 6 of the Regulations. It is to be noted that the health administration of Hong Kong has waited for an extended period of three times the incubation period rather than the minimum of twice the incubation period, before declaring Hong Kong free of infection.

Only one case had been reported and five contacts were isolated in the Quarantine Centre amongst whom were two contact carriers, none of whom had clinical symptoms of cholera. A further 14 carriers were detected from among the 410 inhabitants of the village of Shan Pui as a result of rectal swabbing and were isolated in the Quarantine Centre. The total number of persons isolated in the Quarantine Centre was 32 and included 16 asymptomatic carriers.

India: Madras (P, A). —² On 23 October 1962 the health administration of India declared the local area of Madras (P, A) infected with cholera under the provisions of Article 3 of the Regulations. A subsequent telegram reported 27 cases and 1 death from cholera during the week ended 20 October. For the week ending 27 October 119 cases and 10 deaths were reported. The last previously reported case of cholera in Madras was 7 March 1959; and these are the first cases reported in Madras State since October 1961.

Macao. —¹ One further case of cholera El Tor in a resident child aged 4 was confirmed by laboratory on 25 October. Eleven contacts of this case have been isolated.

As of 1 November, three cases have been reported, one of these being an imported case.
