SURVEILLANCE DE LA VARIOLE¹ — SMALLPOX SURVEILLANCE¹

Jusqu'au 11 juillet, 36 382 cas de variole ont été signalés à l'OMS pour 1968. Le nombre de cas signalés pour la période correspondante de 1967 était de 61 446.

Bien que l'incidence de la maladie ait diminué en 1968 dans la plupart des régions du monde, elle a sensiblement augmenté dans les pays d'Afrique de l'est et du sud, ainsi qu'en témoigne le graphique ci-dessous. Presque tous ces pays ont signalé une augmentation du nombre des cas et dans deux d'entre eux — la République démocratique du Congo et le Burundi — il a déjà été enregistré cette année plus de cas qu'il n'y en avait eu pendant toute l'année 1967. Plus de 74% des cas signalés au Congo ont été enregistrés dans deux des huit provinces (Bandundu et Katanga).

Through 11 July, 36 382 cases of smallpox had been reported to WHO during 1968. This compares with 61 446 cases reported during the comparable period in 1967.

Although most countries and areas of the world have shown a decrease in incidence during 1968, the countries of East and South Africa have recorded a notable increase as shown in the figure below. Virtually all countries have reported an increase in cases and two, Democratic Republic of the Congo and neighbouring Burundi, have already experienced more cases during 1968 than were recorded for all of last year. Of the eight provinces in the Congo, two (Bandundu and Katanga) have reported more than 74% of all cases.

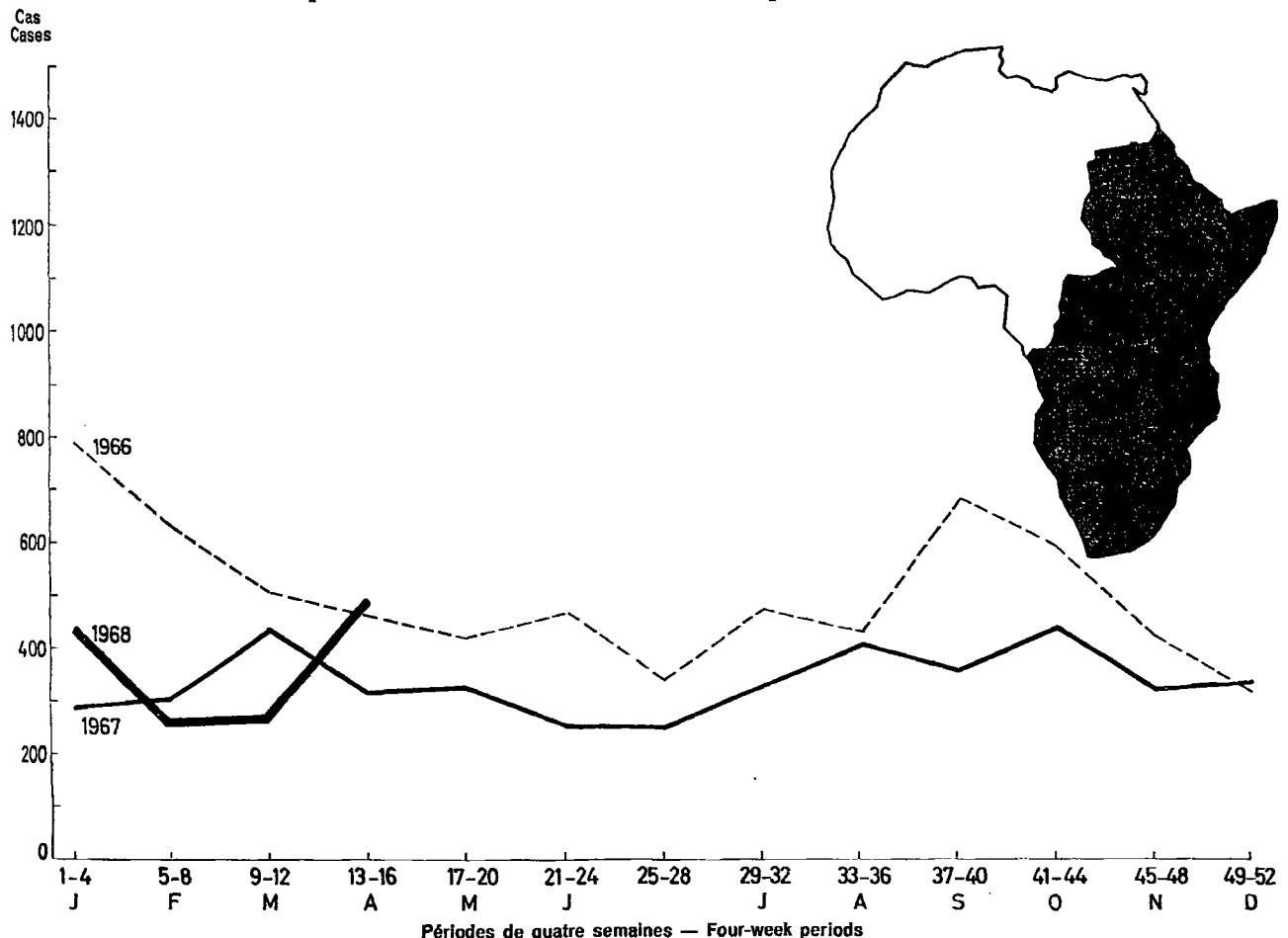

Etats-Unis d'Amérique. — Par télégramme du 12 juillet, l'administration sanitaire a notifié un cas de peste à Denver (Colorado)¹ chez une fillette de six ans admise dans un hôpital d'enfants le 11 juin. L'hémoculture a mis en évidence *P. pestis* qui a ultérieurement été retrouvé dans des ganglions axillaires fluctuants.

Les investigations épidémiologiques ont révélé que l'enfant n'était pas sortie de la ville de Denver au cours des deux dernières années. Elle n'a pas été piquée par des puces et n'a pas eu de contacts avec des rongeurs. On enquête actuellement sur une forte mortalité observée parmi des écureuils dans la zone où se trouve l'habitation de l'enfant.

Bien que la peste ait été reconnue comme enzootique au Colorado, c'est la première fois qu'on signale un cas contracté dans un grand centre urbain de cet Etat.

United States of America. — By cable of 12 July the health administration notified one case of plague in Denver (Colorado)¹ in a six-year old girl, who was admitted to a children's hospital on 11 June. Blood culture, and later fluctuant axillary nodes, yielded *P. pestis*.

Epidemiological investigation revealed that the child had not travelled beyond the city limits of Denver within the last two years. There was no history of flea bites or contact with rodents. A die-off of squirrels in the area of the child's home is presently under investigation.

Although plague has been recognised as enzootic in Colorado, this is the first case acquired in a metropolitan area in the State.

Birmanie. — L'administration sanitaire a notifié, par télégramme du 15 juillet, deux cas de variole (un décès), signalés le 12 juillet dans le District d'Akyab (Division d'Arakan)¹. En janvier-février une épidémie de 18 cas (5 décès) avait été observée dans la même région. Les cas initiaux venaient chaque fois du Pakistan oriental qui est contigu au District d'Akyab.

Burma. — By cable of 15 July, the health administration notified two cases of smallpox (one death) reported on 12 July in Akyab District, Arakan Division.¹ A previous outbreak of 18 cases (5 deaths) was observed in January-February in the same area. In both events, the index cases originated from East Pakistan, contiguous to Akyab District.

France. — ² Le Centre international OMS de référence pour la rage Institut Pasteur de Paris, a confirmé sept cas de rage chez le renard par l'épreuve aux anticorps fluorescents et par inoculation à l'animal de laboratoire pendant la période du 26 mars au 9 juillet. Le 8 juillet, le Centre a confirmé la mort d'un chien, la première de cet épisode et la seule enregistrée pour l'espèce canine sur territoire français depuis 1959. Tous ces cas ont été découverts dans la région de la Moselle qui borde la frontière.

Les mesures préventives déjà annoncées² — contrôle de la circulation des chiens et chats et destruction des carnivores sauvages, en particulier des renards — restent en vigueur.

Il est à noter que la rage chez le chien constitue un plus grand danger pour l'homme que la rage des animaux sauvages.

France. — ² The WHO International Rabies Reference Centre, Pasteur Institute, Paris, has confirmed between 26 March and 9 July seven cases of fox rabies by the fluorescent antibody test and animal inoculation. On 8 July, the Centre confirmed the disease in a dog, the first in the current episode and also the first in this species on French territory since 1959. All these cases occurred in the Moselle region near the frontier.

The preventive measures already reported,² i.e. the control of movements of dogs and cats and destruction of wild carnivores particularly foxes, remain in force.

It may be mentioned that dog rabies constitutes a greater threat to human life than the disease in wildlife.
