

**EB39.R5 Accommodation for the Regional Office for South-East Asia**

The Executive Board,

Noting the report of the Director-General <sup>1</sup> on the consultations which have taken place between him and the Government of India regarding the possible acquisition by WHO of the premises of the Regional Office for South-East Asia,

1. CONSIDERS that the acquisition of this property by the Organization under the generous terms offered by the Government of India would be in the best interests of the long-term development of the work of the South-East Asia Region;
2. NOTES that this proposal would provide a definitive solution concerning the terms of occupancy of these premises by the World Health Organization; and
3. RECOMMENDS to the Twentieth World Health Assembly that it adopt the following resolution:

The Twentieth World Health Assembly,

Noting the recommendations of the Executive Board in resolution EB39.R5 on accommodation for the Regional Office for South-East Asia,

1. CONCURS in the view of the Executive Board that the acquisition of this property by WHO would be in the best interests of the Organization;
2. EXPRESSES its great appreciation of the generosity of the Government of India as shown in the terms under which the premises have been offered to WHO; and
3. AUTHORIZES the Director-General to conclude the arrangements for the acquisition of the property on the lines of the agreement presented to the Executive Board at its thirty-ninth session.
