

The Executive Board,

Having examined the report by the Director-General on the assessment of Bangladesh; ¹

Noting that the United Nations General Assembly, in resolution 3371 (XXX), established an assessment rate of 0.08 % for 1974, 1975 and 1976 for Bangladesh, following its admission to membership of the United Nations on 17 September 1974, corresponding to the following assessment percentages in the WHO scale:

1975, 1976 and 1977	0.08

Recalling the principle, established in resolution WHA8.5 and confirmed in resolution WHA24.12, that the latest available United Nations scale of assessment should be used as a basis of determining the scale of assessment to be used by WHO;

Recalling further that the Twenty-sixth World Health Assembly, in resolution WHA26.21, affirmed its belief that the scale of assessment in WHO should follow as closely as possible that of the United Nations;

Bearing in mind Article 56 of the Constitution, under which the Health Assembly approves the budget estimates and apportions the expenses among the Members in accordance with a scale to be fixed by the Health Assembly,

DECIDES to recommend to the Twenty-ninth World Health Assembly the adoption of the following resolution:

“ The Twenty-ninth Health Assembly,

“ Having considered the recommendations of the Executive Board on the assessment of Bangladesh,

“ DECIDES

(1) to revise the rate of assessment for Bangladesh as follows:

(2) that the contribution of Bangladesh for the year 1976 shall be reduced by the following amounts:

(3) to appropriate from available casual income the sum of US \$114 770 required for those adjustments. ”
