12.1.7.4.5 SCHISTOSOMIASIS

COMMITTEE ON PROGRAMME

Draft Resolution on Schistosomiasis
submitted by the Delegation of Egypt.

WHEREAS the World Health Organization, in order to perform its statutory functions in relation to Chapter II, Art. 2, paragraph (g) of the Constitution, "to stimulate and advance work to eradicate ... endemic and other diseases" and of paragraph (i) "to promote ... the improvement of economic and working conditions and other aspects of environmental hygiene", should take advantage of the advice of experts in the problem of schistosomiasis from various parts of the world,

THE FIRST WORLD HEALTH ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

That the Executive Board be instructed to establish during its first session an advisory Committee of Experts, belonging to the principal countries interested in combating schistosomiasis, and chosen from the various branches of medicine which contribute to the study, prophylaxis and control of this disease.
