AMENDMENTS TO RULES OF PROCEDURE OF THE WORLD HEALTH ASSEMBLY
PROPOSED BY THE GOVERNMENT OF BELGIUM

(Provisional Agenda Item 5)

The amendments to the Rules of Procedure, proposed by the Government of Belgium at the Second World Health Assembly¹ and approved by the Executive Board at its fifth session, are submitted to the Assembly for consideration.² As these rules concern the composition of the main committees, the Assembly may wish to consider them in plenary session before proceeding to the election of the officers of main committees. The following resolution is suggested for the consideration of the Assembly:

The Third World Health Assembly

ADOPTS the following amendments to the Rules of Procedure of the Assembly proposed by the Government of Belgium and approved by the Executive Board at its fifth session:³

Rule 18

At the beginning of each regular session, the Health Assembly shall elect a Committee on Nominations consisting of eighteen delegates of as many Members.

Rule 19

The Committee on Nominations, having regard to an equitable geographic distribution and to experience and personal competence, shall propose (a) to the Health Assembly from among the delegates nominations for the offices of
