REQUEST BY THE REPUBLIC OF THE UNITED STATES OF INDONESIA
FOR INCLUSION IN THE SOUTH-EAST ASIA AREA
(Supplementary Agenda Item 13.2)

The Director-General of the World Health Organization has the honour to present to the Third World Health Assembly a request from the Government of the Republic of the United States of Indonesia for inclusion in the South-East Asia Area. The Third World Health Assembly may wish to adopt the following resolution:

"The Third World Health Assembly:

Having considered the request of the Government of the Republic of the United States of Indonesia for inclusion of Indonesia in Regional Organization Area 3,

RESOLVES

that the Republic of the United States of Indonesia shall from now on form part of Regional Organization Area 3, which comprises the following countries: Burma, Siam, Ceylon, Afghanistan, India.

The Chief Delegate for the Republic of the United States of Indonesia has the honour to inform the President of the Third World Health Assembly that the Government of the Republic of the United States of Indonesia has examined recently the question of the geographical area to which Indonesia should belong. The decision has been taken to join not the Western Pacific area, as is stated in the resolution taken by the First World Health Assembly, but the South East Asia area, together with Burma, Siam, Ceylon, Afghanistan and India.

Consequently, on behalf of his Government the Chief Delegate is transmitting this decision to the President of the Third World Health Assembly in order that the Assembly takes note of this decision and, if necessary, adopts on that subject the pertinent resolution.

The Chief Delegate for the Republic of the United States of Indonesia takes this opportunity to present his compliments to the President of the Third World Health Assembly.
