

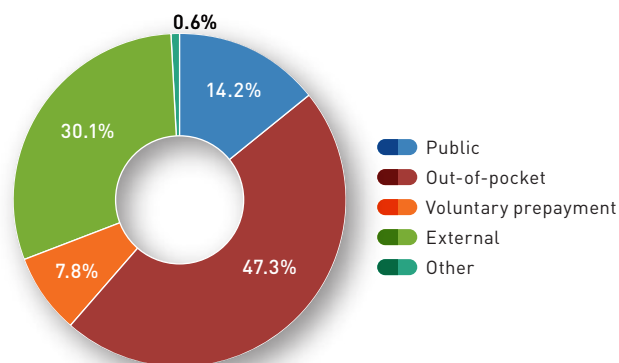

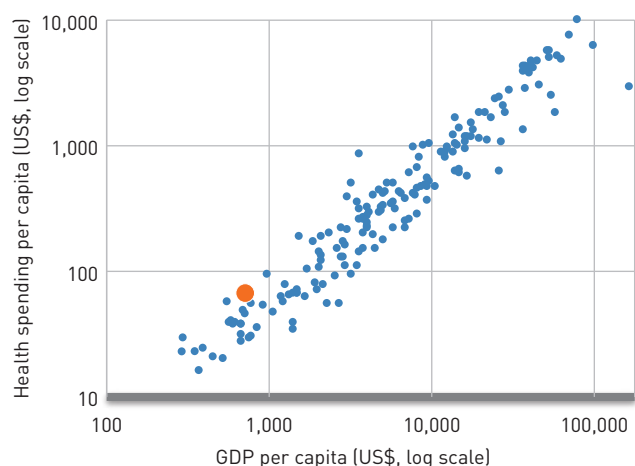

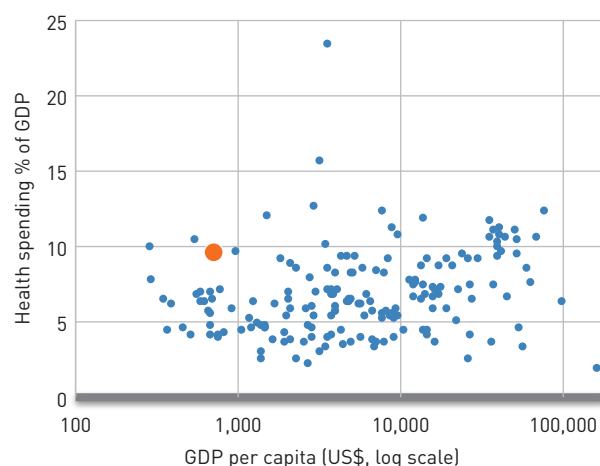
### WHO PAYS FOR HEALTH?



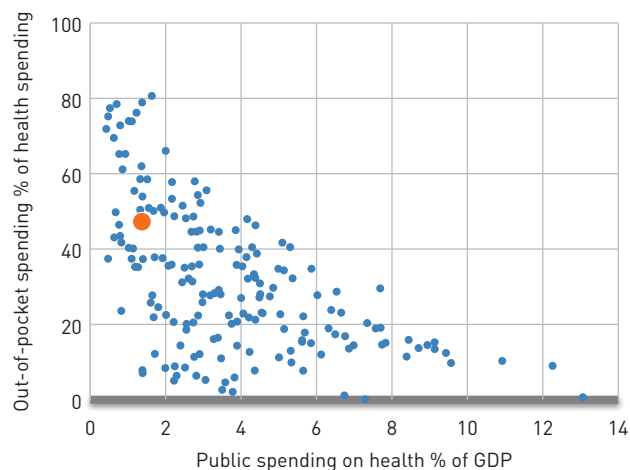
### RICHER COUNTRIES SPEND MORE ON HEALTH...



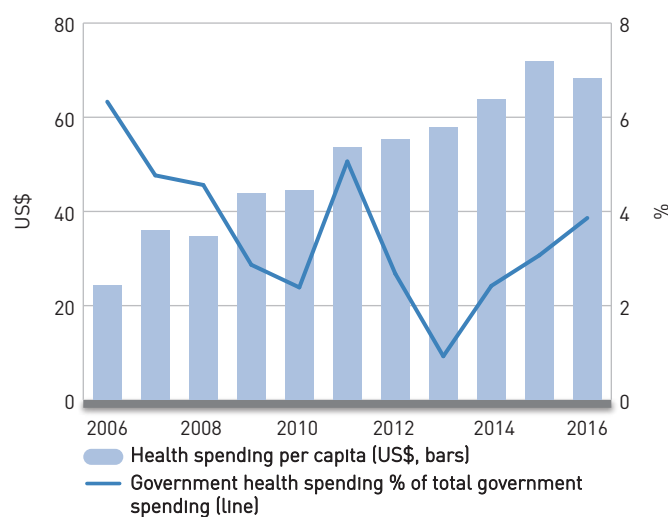
### ...BUT NOT NECESSARILY AS A SHARE OF GDP



### MORE GOVERNMENT SPENDING ON HEALTH IS ASSOCIATED WITH LOWER OUT-OF-POCKET SPENDING

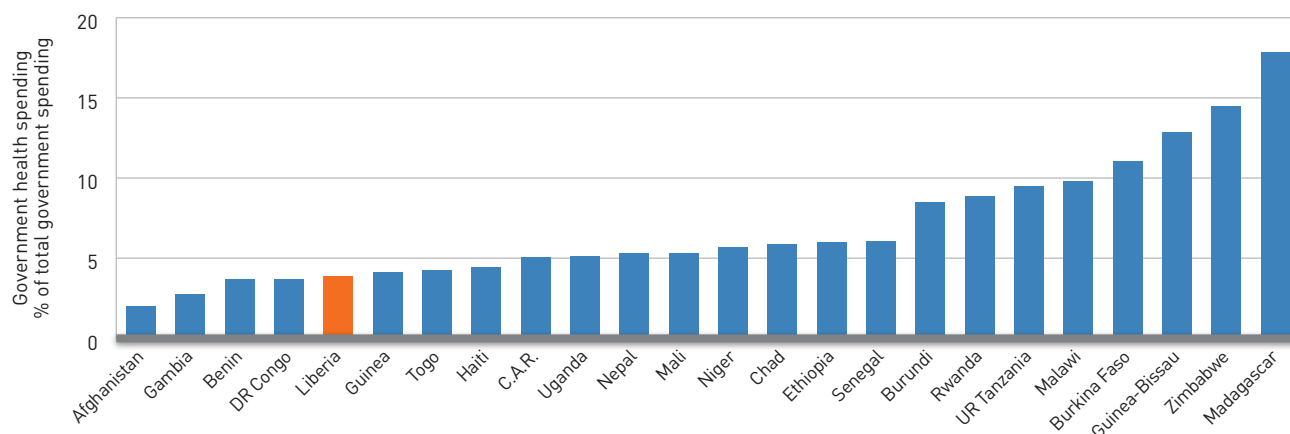

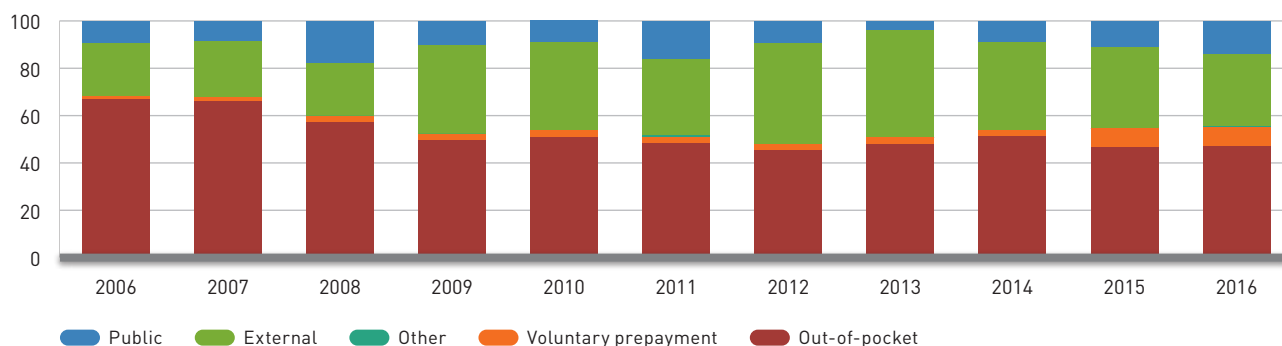

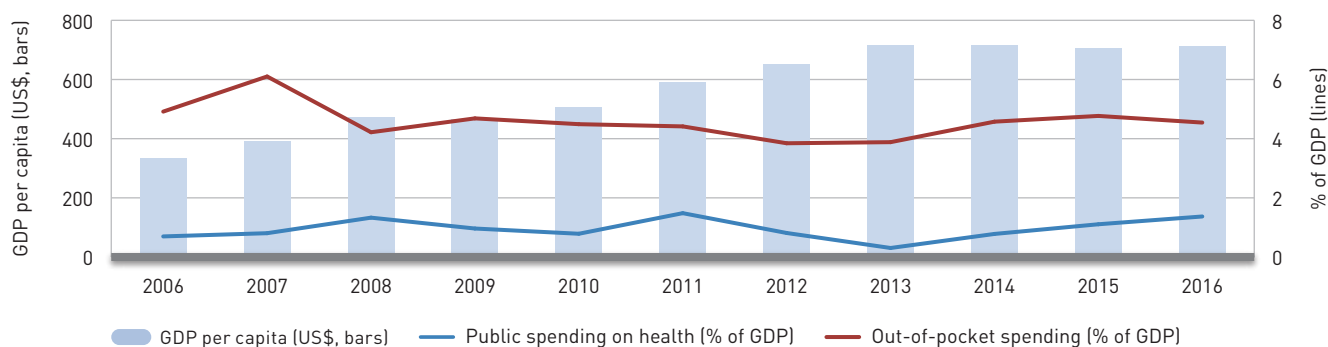
## PRIORITY OF HEALTH IN BUDGET ALLOCATION IS A POLITICAL CHOICE
